Dear Parents,

We here at Christian Worship Center enjoy ministering to your children. What a joy it is for us to sow seed through preaching and teaching the word of God. We want all parents to be assured that we take the responsibility of caring for your children in Children's Church very seriously. Therefore, we would like for you to be made aware of some policies we have in effect. Please take some time to review them and even discuss them with your children.

Our Zero Tolerance Policy is to prevent any child or teacher from being harmed physically, mentally or spiritually.

Zero Tolerance Policy Guidelines

1. No cursing, lying or stealing
2. No hitting or biting
3. No outright acts of rebellion or defiance
4. No malicious behavior towards other children or teachers
5. No weapons of any kind, sticks or any object that would be used to cause bodily harm to another person
6. No exposure of body parts
7. No drugs, alcohol or tobacco
8. No clothing suggesting the above substances
9. No spitting

Each of these offenses may carry various disciplinary actions. We may need to excuse a child from Children's Church for a specified length of time. Each incident will be reviewed individually along with all circumstances. The level of discipline will then be determined by the staff/leadership of this church. Staff / leadership will advise parent and teacher of the consequence for the action.

Our sign in process is very simple. At each sign-in position there is an attendance sheet provided. Please fill in all required information by printing legibly. During the sign in process a number will be provided in the event that you child or teacher need you during the service. In the main sanctuary in the upper left and right hand corners as you face the podium there are illuminated light boards. Please be familiar with your number so that if during the service your child's number is displayed you can respond accordingly. In order to pick you child up from his or her class you will need to have the number card with you. Teachers are directed to not release children if the parents do not have the number. This system helps us protect your children. Although at times this system may be inconvenient please abide by the procedure. There are too many people attending the church for the teachers to know all the parents.

Illness Policy

The following is a list of guidelines that help us to provide excellent care for your child. We are asking that your child have current immunizations.

Your child must be well. If your child manifests any of the symptoms listed below he/she is not permitted to attend any class with other children present.

- Fever greater than 101.5
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Runny nose (sign of infection is green/yellow in color)
- Questionable rashes and/or coughing
- Chicken pox (or exposure to chicken pox)
- Measles
- Impetigo
- Mumps
- Pink eye
- Contagious illnesses of any kind

If your child is being treated with antibiotics, he/she should be on the drug for at least 24 hours before coming to children's church.

Parents should let us know if their children have a continually clear-runny nose or rash due to non-contagious allergies. We realize that some symptoms hang on long after the child is no longer contagious. Remember that we want all of our children to remain healthy and happy.
